

24-core optical cable single reel test



Article Overview

Testing a 24-core optical cable on a single reel involves continuity checks, attenuation measurement, and OTDR inspection to ensure each fiber meets quality standards before installation.

Pre-Inspection Preparation

Before testing, inspect the cable reel for physical damage, correct labeling, and core count verification. Check factory test records and ensure all construction tools, OTDR, light source, and power meter are ready for on-site testing . Familiarize yourself with the engineering design and acceptance criteria to record results accurately .

Continuity and Visual Inspection

Perform a continuity test on each of the 24 fibers to confirm no breaks or severe defects exist along the reel . This can be done using a visual fault locator (VFL) or simple light source and power meter. Inspect the cable for cracks, non-uniformity, or visible damage along its length .

Attenuation Testing

Measure fiber attenuation using an optical loss test set (OLTS) or a light source and power meter (LSPM). Test at the wavelengths the network will operate (commonly 1310 nm and 1550 nm for single-mode fibers). For multi-core cables, ensure each fiber is tested individually to verify link loss and polarity
