What is a Beam Splitter?

A beam splitter is an optical device that divides an incoming light beam into two separate beams, typically one reflected and one transmitted. For example, installing a beam splitter in a teleprompter involves gently aligning the glass and securing it with tabs on a soft surface.
- **Light Source and Alignment:** Ensure the light source is compatible with the splitter's design. Cube and plate splitters often have a designated input face to prevent dam...
