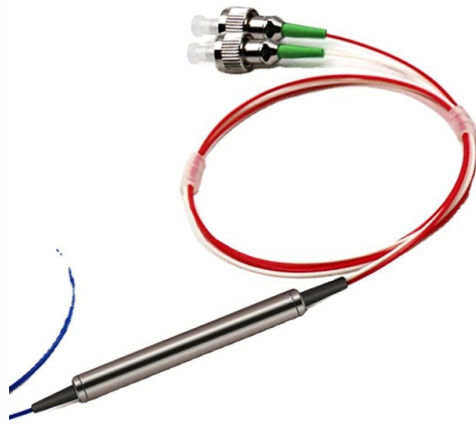

Improperly cleaned fiber end faces have operational and financial implications, but can be avoided. In the real world, this lofty goal is impossible to achieve. Each ring is a zone with its own pass/fail rules. Polishing finalizes the connector endface and cleans the surface, which has a direct impact on optical performance parameters such as insertion loss. This increased deployment of optical fiber networks, and the need for reliable high bandwidth makes the simple task of checking and inspecting connector end-faces a crucial process that must not be neglected.
