Access switches manage end-device connectivity, traffic control, security, and network configuration at the edge of a network.

Core Functions of Access Switches

Access switches are network edge devices that connect end-user hardware such as computers, IP phones, wireless access points, cameras, and IoT devices to the broader network . They sit at the access layer of a hierarchical network and forward traffic upstream to distribution or core switches . Their primary responsibilities include:

- **Port Management:** Access switches provide high port density to connect multiple devices efficiently, supporting speeds like 10/100/1000 Mbps and sometimes 10 Gbps uplinks .
- **Traffic Switching and Forwarding:** They handle incoming and outgoing data packets, directing them to the correct destination using MAC address tables .
- **VLAN Management:** Access switches can segment network traffic into VLANs, isolating different types of traffic for performance and security purposes .
- **Power over Ethernet (PoE):** Many access switches supply power to connected devices such as IP phones, wireless access points, and security cameras .
