The ADSS fiber optic cable laying quota depends on maximum working tension, span length, sag limits, and installation safety standards, which vary by cable type, environmental conditions, and tower/pole configuration.

Key Parameters Affecting ADSS Cable Laying Quota

1. Maximum Working Tension and Rated Tensile Strength (RTS) ADSS cables are designed with a rated tensile strength (RTS) and a maximum working tension, typically limited to 33–50% of RTS to prevent fiber damage. For example, a 12-fiber ADSS cable with 18 kN RTS has a maximum working tension of 6 kN under heavy loading conditions . Pulling tension during installation should not exceed this limit, and strain should remain below 0.8% to avoid long-term creep . 2. Span Length and Sag The allowable span between poles or towers depends on environmental loading (wind, ice) and altitude. Under light loading, a 12-fiber 8 mm diameter cable can span up to 300 meters, while under heavy loading (1900 Pa wind, 12.7 mm ice), the span reduces to 120 meters . Sag increases with temperature; for a 200-meter span, initial sag at 15°C may be 2.8 meters, increasing to 4.1 meters at 85°C, which must be considered for clearance from live conductors . 3. Installation Methods Two main methods are used:

- Stationary Reel Method: The cable reel is fixed at one end, and the cable is pulled through travelers under controlled tension .
- Controlled Paying-Off Method: Ensures stable tension and prevents crushing or bending beyond the minimum radius . 4. Minimum Bending Radius During installation, the cable must not be bent below 20 times its diameter, and after insta...
