

Aerial power lines and optical cables



Article Overview

Aerial power line optical cables are fiber optic cables installed on overhead power lines to provide communication links while coexisting with high-voltage electrical conductors.

Types of Aerial Optical Cables

- OPGW (Optical Power Ground Wire): Combines grounding and communication functions. Optical fibers are housed in a sealed metal tube at the cable core, surrounded by steel and aluminum conductors. OPGW is installed at the top of transmission towers, replacing conventional ground wires, and is immune to electrical interference from the power lines .
- OPPC (Optical Power Phase Conductor): Integrates optical fibers within the phase conductors themselves. It allows simultaneous power transmission and data communication, with fibers protected from electrical effects .
- OPAC (Optical Power Attached Cable) / SkyWrap: A lightweight, all-dielectric fiber optic cable attached to existing conductors. It is helically wrapped around ground or phase wires using specialized equipment, such as the SkyWrap installation system. OPAC is suitable for long spans (>2 km) and tall towers (>200 m), providing additional communication capacity without replacing existing conductors .

Installation Methods

- Helical Wrapping (SkyWrap): The cable is spirally wrapped around the host conductor using a spinning machine, allowing installation while phase conductors remain live or during single-circuit outages. This method is cost-effective and ideal for difficult terr...
