Fiber reduces weight, resists electromagnetic interference, and allows fast data transfer .

Industrial and Aerospace Applications: Fiber cables are used in aerospace, defense, and industrial automation for secure, high-speed communication, immunity to electromagnetic interference, and reliable data transmission in harsh environments .

Lighting and Decorative Uses: Optical fibers transmit “cold” light, making them ideal for architectural lighting, signage, and decorative illumination without heat hazards
