Fiber optic patch cords are not universally compatible; compatibility depends on fiber mode, connector type, and installation requirements.

Key Factors Affecting Compatibility

1. Fiber Mode: Patch cords come in single-mode and multimode varieties. Single-mode fibers have a small core ($\sim 9\mu\text{m}$) for long-distance transmission, while multimode fibers have larger cores ($50\text{--}62.5\mu\text{m}$) for shorter distances. Using a single-mode patch cord on a multimode system—or vice versa—can cause severe signal loss or complete failure, making mode matching essential . 2. Connector Type: Common connectors include LC, SC, FC, and ST, each with unique physical and optical alignment mechanisms. The patch cord connectors must match the ports on the devices or patch panels. Hybrid cords (e.g., LC-SC) exist for connecting devices with different port types, but standard cords are not universally compatible . 3. Jacket Material and Environment: Patch cords are designed for specific environments. Options include PVC for standard indoor use, LSZH for low-smoke areas, and OFNP for plenum spaces. Using a cord with the wrong jacket type can violate safety codes or reduce durability . 4. Polishing and Performance Standards: Connector end-face polishing (e.g., UPC, APC) affects signal reflection and insertion loss. Mismatched polishing types between cords and equipment can degrade performance .
