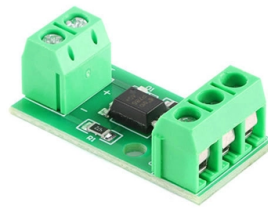

Fiber optic switches, also called optical switches, are devices designed to control the path of light signals within fiber optic networks. They are used in both data networking and storage networking environments. In data networks, fiber switches often appear as Ethernet switches with fiber ports, supporting LAN, WAN, enterprise, and data center applications. In storage networks, Fibre Channel (FC) switches are used to connect servers and storage devices in a Storage Area Network (SAN) for high-performance, lossless data transfer .

Types of Fiber Optic Switches

- **Ethernet Fiber Switches:** These switches provide connectivity between Ethernet devices and fiber optic networks. They can be managed or unmanaged, support PoE (Power over Ethernet), and offer various port configurations from 4 to 52 ports. Many support SFP/SFP+ modules for flexible media conversion and high-speed links up to 10 Gigabit .
- **Fibre Channel Switches:** Primarily used in SANs, these switches follow the Fibre Channel protocol and provide dedicated, high-speed connections between servers and storage devices. They are optimized for lossless, reliable transmission and are...
