They provide a secure environment for fiber connectors and splices, ensuring signal integrity and easy maintenance. Terminal boxes are commonly used in residential or small-scale network installations, often wall-mounted or desktop-mounted, and typically have fewer ports (e.g., 8–12 ports) compared to larger distribution boxes. Distribution Boxes or optical distribution boxes are larger enclosures that manage and distribute multiple fiber optic cables to various endpoints. They act as central hubs in a network, often in data centers or central offices, and can accommodate dozens of ports (e.g., 24–48 or more), providing organized routing and protection for multiple fibers. Junction Boxes, on the other hand, are sometimes confused with terminal boxes due to similar appearance, but they are primarily used for electrical or fiber cable junctions, focusing on cable fixation and environmental protection rather than fiber termination and distribution
