Fusion Splicing: This method uses an electric arc to melt and fuse two fiber ends, producing a permanent joint with very low signal loss, typically less than 0.1 dB, and minimal back reflection, making it ideal for long-haul, high-speed, or mission-critical networks . Fusion splicing requires a fusion splicer that aligns fiber cores precisely and controls the arc for consistent results . **Mechanical Splicing:** This method aligns fiber ends within a housing using an index-matching gel to bridge the microscopic gap. It is faster and requires less equipment but generally results in higher signal loss, typically 0.2–0.75 dB, and slightly higher back reflection. Mechanical splicing is suitable for temporary connections, emergency repairs, or short-distance applications .

Fiber Preparation and Equipment

- Clean and cleave fibers accurately to ensure smooth end faces and proper alignment .
- Use a high-precision cleaver to achieve perpendicular cuts.
- Maintain splicing tools and ensure the fusion splicer or mechanical splice unit is calibrated....
