

# Are trapezoidal cable trays considered fire-resistant cable trays

Trapezoidal cable trays can be fire-resistant if constructed from appropriate materials or treated with fire-resistant coatings, but their shape alone does not guarantee fire protection.

### Material and Design Considerations

The fire resistance of a cable tray depends primarily on the material used and any protective coatings applied, rather than its geometric shape. Common fire-resistant materials include steel, stainless steel, aluminum, and fiber-reinforced plastics (FRP/GRP), with some trays featuring intumescent or thermal-resistant coatings to slow heat transfer and structural failure during fire exposure . Trapezoidal trays made from these materials can maintain structural integrity and protect cables under high temperatures.
