

Basic Speed of Fiber Optic Cable

Fiber optic cables transmit data at speeds approaching 70% of the speed of light, with commercial internet speeds up to 100 Gbps and laboratory experiments exceeding 1 petabit per second.

Practical Internet Speeds

Consumer fiber internet typically offers speeds ranging from 100 Mbps to 10 Gbps, while business and enterprise networks can reach up to 100 Gbps for mission-critical applications. Some regional providers, like EPB in Chattanooga, TN, offer speeds up to 10 Gbps, and multi-gigabit plans are increasingly available. Fiber internet also provides symmetrical upload and download speeds, which reduces latency and improves performance for streaming, gaming, and large file transfers.

Theoretical and Laboratory Speeds

Laboratory experiments have pushed fiber optic transmission to unprecedented levels. For example, researchers in Japan transmitted data at 319 Terabits per second over 1,800 miles, and other studies have achieved speeds exceeding 1.02 petabits per second using advanced techniques like wavelength division multiplexing and multi-core fibers. Theoretically, a single fiber strand could carry up to 44 terabits per second, far beyond current commercial capabilities.
