

Bbu-rru optical cable connection method

The RRU connects to the BBU using high-speed optical fiber, forming a low-latency, high-bandwidth fronthaul link essential for modern wireless networks.

Overview of RRU-BBU Connection

The Remote Radio Unit (RRU) is typically installed near the antennas at the top of a tower, while the Baseband Unit (BBU) is located at the base or in a centralized baseband pool. The RRU converts digital signals from the BBU into RF signals for transmission and vice versa, handling multiple frequency bands and carrier aggregation. To maintain signal integrity and minimize latency, the RRU and BBU are connected via bi-directional optical fiber, often using CPRI or eCPRI protocols.

Optical Fiber Types and Installation

Single-mode optical fibers are commonly used due to their low attenuation and ability to transmit high-speed data over long distances. Proper installation is critical: connectors must be clean and precisely mated to reduce insertion loss, and fibers should be routed to avoid sharp bends or physical stress. In outdoor environments, armored or shielded fibers are recommended to protect against electromagnetic interference and physical damage.

Power and Hybrid Cabling

The RRU requires both optical connectivity and power. These can be delivered via separate cables or combined in hybrid FTTA (Fiber To The Antenna) cables, which in...
