Overview

North American distribution boards are generally housed in enclosures, with the breakers positioned in two columns operable from the front. Some panelboards are provided with a door covering the breaker switch handles, but all are constructed with a dead front; that is to say the front of the enclosure (whether it has a door or not) prevents the operator of the circuit breakers from contacting live electrical parts within. The enclosure carries the current from incoming line (hot) conductors to the breakers.

A branch circuit is the portion of an electrical system that carries power from the distribution box to outlets, lights, or appliances, protected by a circuit breaker or fuse.

Definition and Function

A branch circuit is the final segment of an electrical distribution system that delivers electricity from the distribution box (or panelboard) to individual loads such as receptacles, lighting fixtures, or appliances (). It begins at the overcurrent protection device (OCPD)—typically a circuit breaker or fuse—inside the distribution box, which safeguards the circuit against overloads and short circuits ().

Components of a Branch Circuit

- Overcurrent Protection Device (OCPD): Protects the wiring and connected devices by interrupting excessive current flow ().
- Circuit Conductors: Wires that carry electricity from the OCPD to the load. A standard 120V branch circuit includes:...
