

Cable Tray Cover Standards



Article Overview

Cable tray covers must comply with standards such as NEMA VE 1/VE 2, UL 568, IEC 61537, and NFPA 70 to ensure safety, mechanical strength, and electrical performance.

Key Standards for Cable Tray Covers

NEMA VE 1 and VE 2 These standards specify the manufacturing, installation, and maintenance requirements for metal cable trays, including ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, and channel types. VE 1 covers load/span designations, material specifications, and associated fittings, while VE 2 provides installation guidelines and practical recommendations for aluminum or steel systems, ensuring compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) and harmonization with the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) C22.2 Part 1.

UL 568 This Underwriters Laboratories standard applies to nonmetallic (fiberglass) cable trays and their covers. It defines construction, performance, and testing requirements for continuous systems, including ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, and channel trays, ensuring safe support of power and control cables.

IEC 61537 The International Electrotechnical Commission standard provides global guidelines for metal and nonmetallic cable tray systems, including covers. It specifies mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, electrical continuity, and testing methods to ensure durability and safety in industrial, commercial, and utility installations.

NFPA 70 (National Electrical Code) The NEC outlines installation requirements for cable trays and covers, including ladder, ventilated trough, channel, and solid bottom types. Article 310 addresses conductor ampacities, while other sections ensure proper support, spacing, and protection of cables within covered trays.
