Classification by Tray Type

- **Ladder Tray:** Features two longitudinal side rails connected by cross rungs, resembling a ladder. It allows maximum airflow, effective heat dissipation, and easy cable access from top or bottom. Ideal for power and control cables in industrial settings .
- **Perforated Tray:** Similar to ladder trays but with a solid bottom containing perforations. Provides moderate ventilation while offering more support for smaller cables. Suitable for environments where some protection from dust or debris is needed .
- **Solid Bottom Tray:** Completely enclosed at the bottom, offering maximum protection against moisture, dust, and mechanical damage. Best for sensitive instrumentation or control cables but may trap heat, requiring careful thermal management .
- **Basket Tray:** Made of welded wire mesh, lightweight and flexible. Ideal for routing small cables, telecommunication, and fiber optic cables. Its open design allows easy installation and modifications .
- **Channel Tray:** A U-shaped or C-shaped tray used for short cable runs or branch connections. Often used where aesthetics are important or for small instrumentation cables. Available in solid or ventilated designs .
