

Cable entering the high-voltage distribution box



Article Overview

High-voltage cables entering a distribution box must be carefully routed, terminated, and insulated to ensure safety, reliability, and compliance with standards.

Cable Selection and Preparation

Choosing the correct HV cable is critical. Factors include voltage rating, current capacity, insulation type (XLPE or paper-insulated), and environmental conditions such as temperature and moisture exposure . Cables should be handled carefully to avoid damage to the conductor or insulation, stored on level surfaces, and kept dry before installation .

Routing and Mechanical Considerations

Cables should enter the distribution box with minimal bending and tension to prevent mechanical stress. Proper separation from other cables and equipment is essential to reduce interference and allow heat dissipation . For underground installations, trenches or conduits must provide adequate spacing and protection against external forces .

Termination and Jointing

High-quality terminations are required to connect the cable to busbars or switchgear inside the distribution box. This involves stripping insulation carefully, applying stre...
