

Cable tray connection methods and specifications



Article Overview

Cable tray connections must ensure mechanical stability, electrical continuity, and compliance with applicable standards such as NEMA, UL, or IEC.

Mechanical Connection

Cable trays are typically connected using splice plates, bolts, and fittings to maintain structural integrity. For ladder or ventilated trays, splice plates are bolted across the tray ends, ensuring alignment and load transfer between sections. The bolt size and torque must match manufacturer specifications to prevent loosening under vibration or load. For long runs, intermediate supports are required to maintain tray alignment and prevent sagging, with spacing determined by tray type, material, and load class .

Electrical Continuity and Grounding

Connections must maintain electrical continuity for grounding purposes. Metal trays are usually bonded using grounding lugs or bonding jumpers across joints. This ensures that the tray system can safely carry fault currents and comply with electrical codes. Non-metallic trays may require separate grounding conductors if used in systems where grounding is necessary .
