Key Considerations

Safety and Planning: Installing cable trays in vertical shafts is inherently risky due to the gravitational forces acting on the cables. Only trained professionals should perform these installations, and a detailed plan must account for cable weight, pulling forces, and potential hazards . **Support and Fixation:** Vertical trays must be supported using vertical hangers, clamps, and brackets. Center-hung supports allow easier cable deposition from each side, while threaded rods with washers and hex nuts secure the tray sections in place . Maximum load per hanger typically ranges from 318 kg to 340 kg, with support spacing up to 3.6 m . **Cable Handling:** When pulling cables vertically, consider the tensile strength of the cable and use pulling grips or steel wire socks to prevent rupture. Fail-safe mechanisms, such as secondary steel wires or synchronized cable pushers, are recommended to prevent free fall in case of cable failure . **Tray Material and Type:** Cable trays can be made of steel, aluminum, or other corrosion-resistant materials, selected based on environmental conditions and mechanical requirements . Ladder-type trays are commonly used for vertical runs due to their strength and ease of cable placement . **Installation Method:**

- Position vertical hangers at calculated intervals.
- Thread upper hex nuts onto all-thread rods above the tray bottom....
