- **Support Span:** Longer tray sections reduce the number of joints but may require additional support to prevent deflection. Material thickness and tray type (ladder, perforated, wire mesh) influence the maximum allowable span.
- **Installation Environment:** In tight spaces or areas with frequent bends, shorter sections may be preferred for easier handling and alignment.
- **Future Expansion:** Standard lengths allow for modular installation, making it easier to add additional sections or reroute cables without major modifications.
- **Load Capacity:** The tray's load class, determined by width, depth, and material thickness, affects how long a single section can span without sagging or compromising cable support
