

# Cable tray partition height



## Article Overview

Cable tray heights typically range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume, ventilation needs, and application requirements.

### Standard Heights

The height of a cable tray partition, often referred to as the tray depth or side rail height, controls the vertical stacking capacity of cables and affects heat dissipation and NEC fill compliance . Standard heights generally range from 25mm (1 inch) to 150mm (6 inches), with the exact choice depending on:

- Cable volume: More cables require deeper trays to prevent overcrowding.
- Ventilation requirements: Taller trays allow better airflow, reducing heat buildup.
- Application type: Light-duty installations may use shallower trays, while heavy-duty or industrial applications often require deeper trays for large power or control cables .

### Factors Influencing Tray Height Selection

- Cable Fill Ratio: NEC specifies maximum fill percentages (e.g., 40% for power cables, 50% for control cables). Tray height must accommodate the total cable cross-sectional area while maintaining proper ventilation .
- Future Expansion: Adding 25% spare capacity is recommended to allow for future cable additions without oversizing the tray .
- Tray Type: Ladder, perforated, channel, and wire mesh trays have different structural characteristics, which may influence the optimal height for load support and airflow .
- Load Capacity: Taller trays with reinforced side rails can support heavier cable loa...
