These systems are commonly made of steel or aluminum for strength and durability.

Design and Installation Best Practices

1. Separation of Cable Types: Power and data cables should be routed in separate trays or sections to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI). Maintain at least 12 inches (30 cm) of separation or follow manufacturer recommendations. 2. Vertical Transitions: When cables need to move vertically, use stair-step ladder components, bends, or risers designed for cable ladders. The vertical change should be gradual to avoid sharp bends that could damage cable insulation or reduce signal integrity. 3. Load and Weight Distribution: Ensure the ladder tray can support the combined weight of all installed cables without exceeding its load capacity. Overloading can compromise structural integrity and cable performance. 4. Cable Management:
