Article Overview

Fiber optic cables in trenches are typically installed using conduits and pulling tapes, with specialized hooks or grips to guide the cable safely through the trench.

Trenching and Conduit Installation

Fiber optic cable installation begins with trenching, which can be done using traditional trenchers or microtrenchers for urban areas. Microtrenching involves cutting a narrow trench, usually 0.5–2 inches wide and up to 2 feet deep, minimizing disruption to roads and sidewalks while allowing protective ducts to be laid for the fiber optic cable. Traditional trenching may require deeper trenches, typically 1–1.2 meters (3–4 feet), to protect the conduit from accidental damage. Once the trench is prepared, PVC conduits or innerducts are installed. These conduits protect the fiber and provide a smooth path for pulling the cable. In some cases, a pre-installed pulling tape is included inside the conduit to facilitate cable installation.

Cable Pulling and Hooks

A fiber optic cable hook or pulling grip is used to attach the cable to the pulling tape or winch line. This ensures the cable is guided through the conduit without exceeding its maximum pulling tension or bending beyond its minimum bend radius, which could damage the fibers. The hook or grip must be securely fastened and compatible with the cable type, whether armored, loose-tube, or dielectric. During installation, the cable is pulled steadily, avoiding jerks or sudden tension spikes. In microtrenching, the cable is often laid inside a protective duct, and the trench is then filled with an infill resin, sometimes in two layers: a bright orange warning layer and...
