As a result, placing fiber optic cables near copper or power cables does not degrade signal quality under normal conditions.

### Considerations for Installation

Although fiber optics are immune to EMI, proper installation practices are still important to prevent physical damage or performance issues:

- Maintain separation distances where possible to reduce the risk of accidental damage during maintenance or installation.
- Avoid running parallel paths for long distances if copper cables are unshielded or improperly grounded, as stray electromagnetic fields could indirectly affect connected equipment.
- Use separate conduits or trays for fiber and electrical cables when feasible to sim...
