Considerations for Multimode Fiber

While a single connector type can be used, it is important to ensure:

- Fiber type matching: OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, or OM5 multimode fibers should be paired with connectors designed for multimode use to avoid signal loss.
- Transceiver compatibility: Multimode fibers typically use LED or VCSEL light sources.
