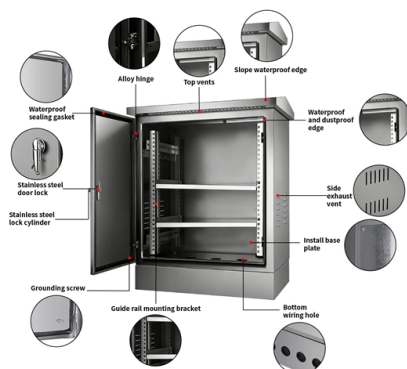


Can a properly connected pigtail allow light to pass through
