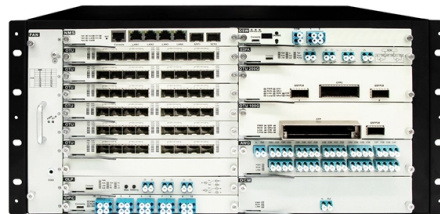

You cannot usually connect a fiber optic cable directly to a standard router; you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or fiber-ready modem to convert the optical signal into an electrical signal your router can use.

Why an ONT or Fiber Modem is Needed

Fiber optic internet transmits data as light pulses, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The ONT serves as the intermediary device, converting the optical signal from the fiber into an electrical signal compatible with your router's Ethernet or WAN port. Most ISPs provide the ONT and install it near the fiber entry point in your home.

Required Equipment

To connect fiber internet to your router, you typically need:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts light signals to electrical signals.
- Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors.
- Ethernet cable: Connects the ONT to your router's WAN port.
- Compatible router: Either a standard router with a WAN port or a fiber-ready router with an SFP port for direct fiber input.
