Requirement of Powered Equipment

While the cable is passive, active electronic components are essential for practical use:

- Internet connections: Devices like Optical Network Terminals (ONTs), routers, and network switches convert electrical signals into light and back, requiring electricity to operate. Even if the fiber strand is intact, a power outage at your home or at the ISP's central office can disrupt service.
- Signal amplification: Over long distances, optical amplifiers may be needed to boost the light signal. These amplifiers are powered and cannot function without electricity.
