

Can power cables and fiber optic cables be co-contained



Article Overview

Generally, power cables and fiber optic cables should not be run in the same conduit, but exceptions exist with proper cable types, separation, or hybrid designs.

General Guidelines

Running fiber optic cables in the same conduit as electrical power cables is generally not recommended due to several risks:

- **Electromagnetic Interference (EMI):** While fiber optics themselves are immune to EMI, the termination equipment and connectors may be affected by nearby electrical cables, potentially degrading signal quality .
- **Heat:** Electrical cables generate heat, which can reduce the lifespan or performance of fiber optic cables .
- **Physical Damage:** Co-locating cables increases the risk of crushing, bending, or abrasion during installation or maintenance .
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Many building codes, including the NEC in the U.S., require separation of power and communication cables to ensure safety and prevent interference .
