

Can the fiber optic cable be connected only to the router

A fiber optic cable cannot usually be connected directly to a standard router; it must first pass through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) that converts the light signal into an Ethernet signal your router can use.

Why Direct Connection Isn't Possible

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light through glass or plastic strands, whereas standard routers use electrical signals over copper Ethernet cables. The physical connectors and signal types are incompatible, so plugging a fiber cable directly into a typical router is not feasible .

Role of the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

The ONT is a device provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP) that serves as the bridge between the fiber network and your home network . Its main functions include:

- Optoelectronic conversion: Converts incoming light signals from the fiber into standard electrical signals.
- Ethernet output: Provides a standard Ethernet port to connect to your router's WAN port.
- Network registration: Communicates with the ISP's central office to authenticate and stabilize the connection. The fiber cable from your ISP connects to the ONT, an...
