How Switches Handle Optical Signals

Modern network switches can interface with fiber-optic networks using optical transceivers, which are small modules that both transmit and receive data as pulses of light over fiber cables . - SFP+: Enhanced version for 10 Gbps and higher speeds.
- QSFP/QSFP+: Supports 40 Gbps or 100 Gbps, often used in data centers for high-bandwidth links . These modules are inserted into compatible switch ports, enabling the switch to receive and transmit optical signals without converting the entire network to optical internally.
