Overheating in incoming cables is primarily caused by overloading, poor connections, inadequate ventilation, insulation degradation, and environmental factors.

Key Causes

1. Overloading: When the current passing through a cable exceeds its rated capacity, the conductor generates excessive heat due to ohmic losses. Even a 10% increase in current can raise the heat generation by over 20%, accelerating insulation aging and increasing the risk of short circuits or fire . 2. Poor Connections: Loose, corroded, or improperly crimped connections increase contact resistance, causing localized heating at joints. This can lead to hot spots, insulation damage, and potential phase-to-phase short circuits . 3. Inadequate Cable Sizing: Using a cable with a cross-section too small for the load results in long-term overload. For example, a 2.5mm² cable carrying a load meant for 4mm² can exceed safe temperature limits by 15–20°C . 4. Insufficient Ventilation: Cables installed in confined spaces, densely packed, or near other heat sources cannot dissipate heat effectively. Dense cable arrangements can increase central cable temperatures by over 40% compared to a single cable . 5. Insulation Degradation: Aging cables, damaged sheaths, or water ingress reduce insulation resistance, causing additional heating. PVC insulation, for instance, is safe below 60°C, but prolonged overheating can lead to breakdown and fire hazards . 6. Environmental Factors: High ambient temperatures, exposure to chemicals, or proximity to heat-emitting equipment can exacerbate cable heating and accelerate insulation deterioration . 7.
