

Classification and Structure of Cable Trays

Cable trays are classified by their structural design into ladder, perforated, solid-bottom, basket, and channel types, each optimized for specific cable support, ventilation, and load requirements.

Ladder Cable Trays

Ladder trays consist of two longitudinal side rails connected by transverse rungs, resembling a ladder. The rungs are typically spaced at 6, 9, or 12 inches, allowing maximum airflow and heat dissipation, which is ideal for power cables that generate heat during operation. Ladder trays can support heavy cable loads over long spans and are commonly used in industrial and utility-scale installations due to their strength and ventilation efficiency .

Perforated Cable Trays

Perforated trays have a solid bottom with regularly spaced holes or slots. This design provides moderate ventilation while offering more protection than ladder trays. They are suitable for installations where some airflow is needed but where cables also require additional support or protection from debris .
