

Classification of Alloy and Plastic Cable Trays

Cable trays are classified based on material into alloy (metallic) trays such as steel, stainless steel, and aluminum, and plastic trays made from PVC or FRP, each suited for specific load, environmental, and corrosion conditions.

Alloy (Metallic) Cable Trays

1. **Steel Cable Trays** Steel is the most widely used material due to its strength, durability, and load-bearing capacity, making it ideal for industrial, data center, and overhead installations . Steel trays can be further classified as:

- **Galvanized Steel:** Coated with zinc to resist corrosion, suitable for indoor and outdoor use .
- **Stainless Steel (AISI 316L):** Contains chromium and molybdenum, offering high corrosion resistance, especially in humid, coastal, or chemically aggressive environments .
- **Pre-galvanized Steel:** Economical option for general corrosion protection .

2. **Aluminum Cable Trays** Aluminum trays are lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and non-magnetic, reducing electrical losses. They are often fabricated from 6063 series alloys containing silicon and magnesium, providing good formability and structural strength . Aluminum is suitable for indoor and some outdoor applications, particularly where weight reduction is important .

Key Properties of Alloy Trays:

- High mechanical strength (steel > aluminum)
- Corrosion resistance varies by alloy and coating...
