

Color Requirements for Armored Optical Cable Pigtails

Single-mode armored pigtails are typically yellow, while multimode armored pigtails are usually orange, following TIA/EIA-598 color standards.

Standard Color Coding

Armored optical cable pigtails follow TIA/EIA-598 color coding for fiber identification, which ensures consistency across installations and simplifies maintenance. The color coding is applied to the fiber jacket or buffer tube and helps distinguish fiber types and counts:

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF): Yellow jacket; commonly used for 1310nm and 1550nm wavelengths, supporting long-distance transmissions up to 40 km.
- Multimode Fiber (MMF): Orange jacket for OM1/OM2 fibers, and aqua for OM3/OM4 fibers; typically used for 850nm or 1300nm wavelengths, supporting shorter distances (up to 500m for OM1/OM2).
- Fiber Count Identification: For cables with multiple fibers, each fiber within a tube or ribbon is assigned a unique color according to the TIA/EIA-598 sequence: blue, orange, green, brown, slate, white, red, black, yellow, violet, rose, aqua. This sequence repeats for higher fiber counts.
