Fiber optic cables are classified by mode, core size, attenuation, bandwidth, and application, with singlemode (OS1, OS2) for long distances and multimode (OM1-OM5) for shorter, high-speed links.

Fiber Optic Cable Types

Singlemode Fiber (SMF) Singlemode cables have a small core diameter of about 9 microns, allowing only one mode of light to propagate. This minimizes signal dispersion and supports long-distance, high-speed transmission. Common specifications include:

- OS1: Maximum attenuation of 0.4 dB/km at 1310 nm and 0.3 dB/km at 1550 nm, supporting up to 10 km at 10 Gbps .
 - OS2: Maximum attenuation of 0.3 dB/km at 1310 nm and 1550 nm, supporting distances up to 40 km at 10 Gbps . Singlemode fibers are typically used in backbone networks, long-haul telecommunications, and high-speed data centers .
- Multimode Fiber (MMF)** Multimode cables have larger cores (50-62.5 microns), allowing multiple light modes. They are suitable for shorter distances and cost-effective installations.

Variants include:

- OM1: 62.5-micron core, LED light source, up to 300 meters at 10 Gbps .
- OM2: 50-micron core, LED, suitable for moderate distances.
- OM3/OM4: 50-micron core, laser-optimized for 10G, 40G, and 100G transmission; OM4 supports longer distances than OM3
