- Wire Mesh (Basket) Trays: Ideal for data and low-voltage cables due to flexibility and ventilation .
 - Ladder Trays: Suitable for heavy power cables; provide strength and allow airflow .
 - Perforated Trays: Balance protection and ventilation, often used for mixed cable types .
 - Solid Bottom Trays: Offer maximum protection from dust and water but limit airflow, requiring careful heat management .
3. Layout and Routing:
- Keep trays organized and clearly marked for easy identification and maintenance .
 - Maintain separation between power and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference .
 - Avoid blocking airflow in hot aisle/cold aisle configurations; trays should complement cooling strategies
