

Configuration of Digital Monitoring Core Switch

A digital monitoring core switch should be configured with full gigabit uplinks, integrated monitoring interfaces, and proper bandwidth planning to ensure reliable data flow and environmental monitoring.

Core Switch Role and Selection

The core switch serves as the backbone of a hierarchical network, connecting aggregation and access layer switches while routing and switching large volumes of data. Key considerations for selecting a core switch include high forwarding rate, Quality of Service (QoS) support, redundancy, and compliance with Ethernet protocols. For large monitoring systems, a full gigabit port core switch is recommended to handle high-definition video streams and multiple VLANs efficiently.

Monitoring Interface Configuration

Monitoring interfaces allow the network management system (NMS) to track the status of switch components such as maintenance compartment doors, cabinet doors, and backup power supplies. To configure these interfaces:

- Connect the monitoring interfaces to sensors for doors and power supplies.
- Configure the DOUT status to reflect the normal state of doors (enabled or disabled)....
