Identify the Correct Cord and Connectors Ensure the yellow patch cord is the right type for your network (single-mode fiber is typically yellow) and that the connectors (SC/APC, SC/UPC, LC, etc.) match the devices you are connecting, such as an ONT, router, or patch panel . 2. Prepare a Clean Workspace Work in a dust-free area. Gather tools like fiber cleaning wipes or a fiber optic cleaning kit. Avoid touching the fiber end faces with your fingers . 3. Clean the Connectors Before connecting, clean both ends of the patch cord and the device ports using a fiber optic cleaning tool or lint-free wipes. Dirt or dust can cause signal loss . 4. Check Bend Radius Do not bend the fiber sharply. Maintain the minimum bend radius (usually 30–50 mm for patch cords) to prevent attenuation or damage . 5. Connect the Patch Cord

- Insert one end of the yellow fiber patch cord into the wall outlet or ONT port.
 - Insert the other end into the router, switch, or patch panel port. Ensure the connector clicks or seats fully and is properly aligned .
 - Avoid forcing the connector; it should slide in smoothly.
6. Verify the Connection Power on the devices and check the status lights. Use a fiber optic power meter if available to confirm signal transmission and check for insertion loss or return loss
