

Connecting a beam splitter to a surveillance camera



Article Overview

To connect a beam splitter to a surveillance camera, use a BNC-compatible video splitter with RG59 or RG6 coaxial cable, connecting the camera output to the splitter input and the splitter outputs to your DVRs or monitors.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Identify the Camera Cable Type Most CCTV and HD cameras use coaxial cables (RG59 or RG6) with BNC connectors for video transmission . Ensure your camera cable has a BNC male connector at the end.
- Select a Compatible Video Splitter Use a CCTV video splitter (e.g., VDS-102HD) that supports your camera type (analog, HD-TVI, AHD, or HDCVI). The splitter should have one BNC input and two or more BNC outputs .
- Connect the Camera to the Splitter
 - Plug the BNC connector from the camera cable into the input port of the splitter.
 - Ensure the connection is secure by twisting the BNC connector until it locks in place.
- Connect the Splitter Outputs to Devices
 - Use additional RG59 or RG6 coaxial cables with BNC connectors to connect the splitter outputs to your DVRs, NVRs, or monitors .
 - Each output can feed a separate recording or display device.
- Power the Splitter
 - Most splitters require a 12V DC power supply, which is usually included. Connect t...
