

Connecting a core switch to a regular router



Article Overview

To connect a core switch to a router, establish a physical Ethernet link, configure IP addressing, and optionally set up VLANs and routing protocols for efficient network communication.

Physical Connection

Begin by connecting the core switch to the router using a high-quality Ethernet cable. Identify the appropriate ports on both devices—typically a Gigabit Ethernet port on the router and a corresponding port on the core switch. Ensure both devices are powered off during the initial connection to prevent electrical issues, then power them on after the cable is securely connected .

IP Addressing and VLAN Configuration

Assign IP addresses and subnet masks to the interfaces on both the router and the core switch. If the switch is a Layer 3 device, you can configure a routed port (no switchport) on the switch interface, which avoids Layer 2 protocols like STP on that link and simplifies routing . Alternatively, you can place the switch port in a VLAN and assign the router interface an IP in that VLAN, though routed ports are generally preferred for core connections. For networks with multiple VLANs, configure trunking on the switch and router interfaces to allow VLAN traffic to pass through. This ensures devices on different VLANs can communicate via the router
