

Connection method of external wall cable tray



Article Overview

External wall-mounted cable trays are connected using wall brackets or cantilever supports, secured with bolts and anchors, and joined end-to-end with splice plates or couplers for stability and grounding.

Wall Mounting and Brackets

For external wall installations, cantilever or wall brackets are commonly used. These brackets are fixed to the wall using suitable anchors, such as expansion bolts for concrete or masonry walls, ensuring a strong and level support for the tray. The brackets must be aligned and leveled to prevent sagging and maintain proper cable routing. Standard support spacing is typically 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on the tray type and load.

Joining Cable Tray Sections

Cable tray sections are connected end-to-end using splice plates or couplers, which are bolted to the tray flanges. This ensures mechanical stability, load-bearing capacity, and alignment across long runs. Properly joined trays prevent sagging, reduce vibration, and maintain a neat appearance. For outdoor installations, corrosion-resistant materials like stainless steel or fiberglass are recommended.
