

Connection to the terminal block of the distribution box



Article Overview

To connect a terminal block in a distribution box, strip the wire, insert it into the correct terminal, and secure it with the screw or clamp while ensuring the power is off.

Step 1: Safety First

Always turn off the power to the distribution box before starting any wiring work to prevent electric shock or equipment damage . Ensure your workspace is clean and dry, and use insulated tools.

Step 2: Select the Correct Terminal Block

Choose a terminal block that matches the wire gauge, voltage, and current rating of your circuit. Consider the environment (temperature, vibration, humidity) and whether you need a screw, spring, or push-in type . DIN rail-mounted blocks are common in distribution boxes for organized installation.

Step 3: Prepare the Wires

- Cut the wire to the appropriate length, leaving enough slack for maintenance but avoiding clutter.
- Strip the insulation from the wire end (typically 6-10 mm depending on the terminal block type) to expose the conductor
