

Construction Scheme for Trapezoidal Cable Trays

Trapezoidal cable trays are constructed from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with a trapezoidal side profile for enhanced strength and load-bearing capacity, and are typically hot-dip galvanized or otherwise treated for corrosion resistance.

Materials and Surface Finishes

Trapezoidal cable trays are commonly made from high-quality steel plates, stainless steel (304/316), or aluminum, depending on the environmental conditions and mechanical requirements. Steel trays are often hot-dip galvanized to provide a thick, durable zinc layer that protects against corrosion, while stainless steel offers inherent corrosion resistance, particularly in harsh or chemical environments. Aluminum trays are lightweight and resistant to atmospheric corrosion due to a natural oxide layer, making them suitable for outdoor or humid environments.

Dimensions and Design

The trapezoidal shape features side rails with heights typically ranging from 50 mm to 200 mm, and tray widths from 100 mm to 1000 mm, with lengths commonly 2000 mm, 2400 mm, 3000 mm, or 6000 mm, though custom sizes are available. The trapezoidal profile increases the tray's structural rigidity, allowing it to support heavier cable loads over longer spans compared to flat-bottomed trays. Tray thickness usually ranges from 0.9 mm to 3.0 mm, depending on load requirements....
