Core switches form the high-speed backbone of enterprise networks, while enterprise routers manage external connectivity and inter-network traffic.

Core Switches

A core switch is a high-capacity, high-performance Layer 3 switch positioned at the backbone of an enterprise network, aggregating data from distribution switches and ensuring ultra-low latency and maximum throughput across the LAN or data center . Core switches are designed for speed, reliability, and scalability, focusing on rapid data forwarding rather than resource-intensive tasks like deep packet inspection or granular access control, which are delegated to lower layers . They are central to the three-tier hierarchical network model, connecting aggregation/distribution switches to provide seamless communication across the enterprise . Key features of core switches include:

- High throughput and wire-speed performance
- Redundancy and fault tolerance
- Support for advanced routing and virtualization
- Modular or fixed configurations for flexible deployment
- Integration with network management and security platforms
