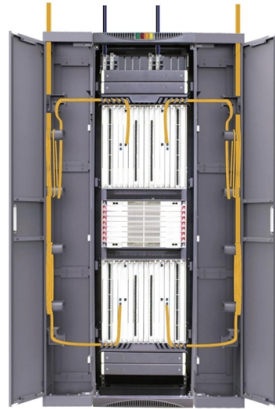


Correct method for cables under the distribution box



Article Overview

Cables under a distribution box should be routed in organized, protected pathways using conduits or trays to ensure safety, accessibility, and compliance with standards.

Proper Routing and Containment

Cables beneath a distribution box or under raised floors should be installed in cable trays, baskets, or flexible conduits to maintain order and prevent damage. Flexible conduits, such as liquid-tight flexible metal conduit (LFMC), are commonly used to protect power distribution cables while allowing easy access for maintenance or future expansion . For underfloor installations, cables can also be routed through underfloor boxes or trunking systems, which provide a robust and modular solution for both power and data cabling .

Segregation and Safety

It is essential to segregate power and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain system integrity. Cables should be pulled in plenum-rated pathways if installed in spaces used for air circulation, ensuring compliance with fire and safety regulations . All components, including cable trays and conduits, should be solidly bonded to minimize perturbations and maintain electromagnetic compatibility
