

Coupler Fiber Pigtail



Article Overview

A coupler fiber pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed to connect fiber optic couplers or collimators to network cables via splicing.

Definition and Structure

A fiber pigtail is a short length of optical fiber, typically 0.5 to 2 meters, with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end is polished and tested for low insertion loss and high return loss, while the bare end is intended for fusion or mechanical splicing to the main fiber cable in the field. When used with a coupler or GRIN collimator, the pigtail allows precise alignment and connection between the optical device and the fiber network.

Applications

Coupler fiber pigtails are commonly used in:

- Optical distribution frames (ODFs) and patch panels for terminating bulk fiber cables.
- Fiber optic couplers and splitters, where the pigtail connects the coupler's input/output ports to the network fibers.
- Laboratory setups with GRIN lenses or collimators, enabling free-space beam coupling while maintaining fiber connectivity.
- FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments, where pigtails provide reliable, low-loss connections to subscriber lines
