

Crossing the street and passing fiber optic cables

Fiber optic cables are typically installed underground in protective conduits or aerially on poles, designed to be safe and durable when crossing streets.

Underground Fiber Installation

Fiber optic cables are often buried in conduits 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to protect them from accidental damage, including street crossings . In colder climates, cables may be buried deeper to avoid frost penetration. The installation process involves digging trenches or using directional boring to pass under streets and sidewalks without disturbing the surface . Conduits are usually made of PVC or similar materials, sometimes with inner ducts to facilitate cable pulling. A conductive marker tape is often buried above the conduit to help locate it in the future and warn against accidental digging .

Aerial Fiber Installation

In some areas, fiber is installed aerially on utility poles, sometimes alongside power lines . Special All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables are used, which are non-conductive and resistant to electrical interference, crushing, and extreme weather . These cables are designed to withstand environmental stress and remain safe for pedestrians and vehicles below.
