

Dimensions of Fiber Optic Cable Trays for Intelligent Buildings

Fiber optic cable trays for intelligent buildings typically range from 120mm to 360mm in width, with depths and lengths standardized to support cable fill, load, and future expansion.

Standard Dimensions

Fiber optic cable trays are designed with width, depth, length, and material thickness in mind to ensure proper cable routing, heat dissipation, and structural integrity. Common widths include 120mm, 240mm, and 360mm, with corresponding maximum working loads of 100kg, 220kg, and 300kg per 2 meters, respectively. Depth (side rail height) is selected based on the number of fibers and allowable fill percentage, typically following NEC or IEC guidelines. Lengths are often modular, with straight channel sections available in 6.5ft (approximately 2 meters), which can be cut or joined with elbows, tees, and crosses for flexible routing.

Tray Types and Compatibility

Fiber optic trays can be standalone or integrated with systems like the FibeRoad™ System, supporting up to 24 fibers with SC or LC connectors and additional PLC splitter capacity. Trays are compatible with various fiber types and splice holders, allowing for both patch cord and multi-fiber cable management. Raceway systems protect cables from mechanical stress and facilitate moves, adds, or changes in intelligent building networks
